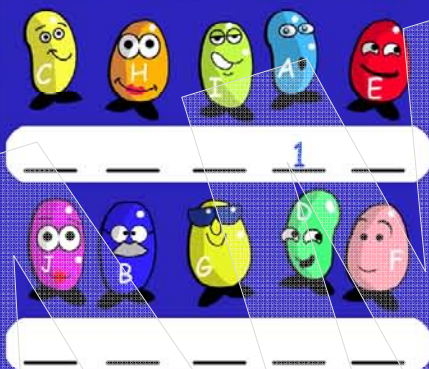


Janet and John jumped for joy when Jason said he could change the jar of jumping beans for Juniper berry juice.
